 - Peloton truck platooning
 - ATC visioning work
- 3. ATC Vision Project (15 minutes) Peter Rafferty, Gannett Fleming
 - Peter provided info on ATC planning
 - No one on ATC or its subcommittees has to be an expert in this field; you are experts in your own areas
 - Reviewed slides; tactical and programmatic prongs
 - Daniel Yeh legislative and administrative rules? What about other states that have put laws/rules into place that we can learn from?
 - Peter A good thing for the subcommittee. ATC is to inform and offer recommendations to the state of Iowa.
 - Adam what other states are doing is constantly changing

- 4. Update on recent AV-related legislation (30 minutes) Dan McGehee, University of Iowa National Advanced Driving Simulator
 - Chris Cournoyer SF302 wanted to get text in there as a framework, they see the huge economic benefit for AVs
 - Sent Senate tracking doc to group
 - Ashley Hinson HF387 previous platooning bill a few years ago didn't go through, modeled this after other states with a reasonable and prudent following distance, braking systems are tethered on Iowa roads
 - Dan done in other states, we're learning from that (leading from behind), be able to adjust as we go, some language
 - Mike Steenhoek who provides that validation? Language minimal risk conditions? Who defines that? Is it the DOT? That's the next step that he sees.
 - Chris section 6 says the Iowa Code/DOT will govern
 - Peter what happens July 1st (when this legislation becomes effective)?
 - Dan AVs will not show up July 1st, we have time
 - Adam Iowa DOT internal meeting a week from today with administrative staff, legislative analyst, traffic operations, etc. to discuss this legislation
 - Peter role of the subcommittee?
 - Adam DOT is discussing things like fiber in the right of way
 - Donna trying to look at this regionally, truckers moving from one state to another – it's important to coordinate infrastructure efforts to make this work best
 - Adam infrastructure like pavement marking is even important (4" to 6" for cameras to see them better)
 - Dylan two bills that have been passed. Do we know what future bills are needed?
 - Dan get feedback from OEMs
 - Chris work with DOT and DPS, others to get the framework better defined and in place
 - Sometimes bills take years to get through, starts the conversation it's a framework with the understanding that there's more to come
 - It's monumental this got approved
 - Peter goal of the subcommittee is to reduce barriers. Anyone who can seed the next steps for the subcommittee?
 - Dylan is there a set of things other states that are further along to allow platooning or driverless vehicles? Other things they've done that we need to figure out?
 - Chris Education part of it will be important (people concerned about driverless cars). Be proactive on awareness, what AVs are. Making sure the public understands what it is, what it isn't.
 - Ashley this is a good opportunity for a social media campaign for awareness. Is there something that exists that could help spread the word about this technology?
 - Daniel Iowa Code doesn't require certain elements like hands on wheel or a steering wheel, manual control of the vehicle, etc. Barriers in other states that have requirements. Need to do a little more looking in Iowa Code that need to be reviewed.
 - $\circ \quad \text{Chris}-\text{made sure the bill left those things out}$
 - Melissa meeting scheduled next week to discuss both of these bills more in-depth
